#### Community Assessment Hub for vulnerable groups at the Mater Hospital.

We are open for referrals of patients who are covid positive or presumed positive requiring face-toface GP assessment/ review.

This bespoke cross-city service will better suit the needs of marginalised groups including:

- People experiencing homelessness
- People with addiction issues,
- Those living in congregated or overcrowded settings,
- Vulnerable people from the Roma community,
- People who do not have access to a GP
- Those who require the support of additional services including interpreting services.

Or those who cannot access other Community Assessment Hubs

Transport can be arranged if necessary for patients to and from appointments.
